The opening of the LDLC Arena, the Groupama Stadium attracts sporting events, concerts, and corporate events. Moreover, from grand luxury hotels in the city centre or small family-run hotels to hotel residences, Lyon offers a very wide range of accommodation to satisfy all your attendees.
