The Couvent des Jacobins

The **Couvent des Jacobins**, rennes convention center, located just **5 minutes** from the train station by metro and in the heart of Rennes' historic center, is close to major cultural sites such as the Opera, the Town Hall, and the Parc du Thabor. This venue attracts visitors with its variety of shops, restaurants, and cultural events.

It features two auditoriums: the Grand Auditorium with **1,000** seats and the Nef with **300** seats, as well as **4,000** m² of exhibition space and **25** meeting rooms that can accommodate between **40** and **400** people. Its unique architecture in Europe and outdoor spaces, such as the panoramic terrace and the Cloister Garden, provide an ideal setting for business events, exhibitions, or cocktails. The facilities are equipped with the latest technology in acoustics, audiovisuals, and internet connectivity, ensuring an exceptional experience. The modular rooms can adapt to various formats of









professional meetings, facilitating movement with interactive displays.










